## Minutes of the Daviess County Commission August 23, 2023

The Honorable Daviess County Commission met on this 23rd day of August 2023 at 8:00 a.m. Jim Ruse, Presiding Commissioner, called the meeting to order. David Cox 1<sup>st</sup> District and Wayne Uthe 2<sup>nd</sup> District are present.

The Commission approved last week's minutes, brush letters, and invoices for payment.

James Lewis, Road and bridge Supervisor, updated the Commission with a current list of completed tubes and a list of tubes yet to be installed. The crew put two tubes on Otter Avenue and one on Oval Avenue in Liberty Township.

Rachel Taylor, County Clerk, updated the Commission that the insurance is finally moving forward for the Courthouse Roof. The Commission will put together specs for a new roof so the official bid process can begin.

The Commission received a notice of concern about a low water crossing on 110<sup>th</sup> Street in Jefferson Township, they plan to look at this area this afternoon. Issue continued.

Aaron Piburn, Assessor, gave the Commission his certificate of training for his Mappers Conference. Aaron has completed all his training hours for 2023.

A citizen from Benton Township that was scheduled to meet with the Commission decided to cancel at this time.

The Commission discussed that the Nursing Home needs several air conditioner window units. Since the Courthouse has been transitioning to the new mini-split system, the unneeded units will go to the Nursing Home until they no longer require them.

Larry Adams, Sheriff, met with the Commission to update that he will put several surplus vehicles up for bid, as they are no longer needed. The Commission also discussed that they are still taking bids on the County vehicles until Wednesday at 9:00 a.m. at which time they will open the bids.

In the afternoon the Commissioners inspected roads, culverts, bridges, and brush in Jefferson Township.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:00 p.m.
