Rebecca TenHulzen, Green Hills Regional Planning, and Donald Graham, Coffey Fire Department, met with the Commission to further discuss the possibility of getting a grant to help the fire station build a new building. Rebecca plans to meet again next week to provide a few more details on the paperwork process.

Richard Evans, Colfax Township, met with the Commission to discuss the upcoming election. Richard does not plan to run for the township board again but believes someone else will step up and file for candidacy.

In the afternoon the Commissioners inspected roads, culverts, bridges, and brush in Grand River and Salem Townships.
