Minutes of the Daviess County Commission May 15, 2024

The Honorable Daviess County Commission met on this 15th day of May 2024 at 8:00 a.m. Jim Ruse, Presiding Commissioner called the meeting to order. David Cox, 1st District, and Wayne Uthe, 2nd District are present.

The Commission approved last week's minutes, brush letters, and invoices for payment.

James Lewis, Road and Bridge Supervisor updated the Commission on the projects they have worked on since last Wednesday. The crew replaced boards on a couple of bridges in Washington and Monroe Townships. The crew inspected silt around a bridge in Washington Township. Wayne requested an inspection of two tubes on Reel Avenue in Jefferson Township.

The Commission reviewed BRO 39 Progressive Invoice #12, David Cox made a motion to approve the invoice, Wayne Uthe seconded the motion. 3 – Aye, 0 – No. Motion passed.

Aaron Piburn, Assessor, presented 32 hours of continuing education his association requires.

Discussion was held on a leak in the roof of the South Property Annex building, further inspection is needed to determine the best possible repair plans. Issue continued.

Larry Adam, Sheriff, requested the Commission sign a Drug Task Force contract and grant. Wayne Uthe made a motion to approve the contract, David Cox seconded the motion. 3 – Aye, 0 – No. Motion passed.
