The Honorable Daviess County Commission met on Wednesday, October 22, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. Jim Ruse, Presiding Commissioner, called the meeting to order. David Cox, 1st District, is present. Wayne Uthe, 2nd District, is absent.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Commission reviewed the 2026 Children's Mercy Agreement. David Cox made a motion to accept and sign the agreement. Jim Ruse seconded the motion. 2 – Aye, 0 – No. Motion passed.

Shonna Morrison, 3C Power in Partnership, met with the Commission to update them on the process of getting new roll-up doors in her portion of the South property building. She received only two bids, and one was a bid for only half of the work. Jim recommended that Shonna keep good notes, as she only received two bids. The Commission is on board with the changes. Shonna's organization will pay for the updates through grants.

The Commission reviewed the current 2025 01 and 02 fund financials for 2026 pre-budget planning.

The Commission was informed that the County's work comp rate will be reduced next year due to low work comp claims.
