The Honorable Daviess County Commission met on Wednesday, April 22, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. Jim Ruse, Presiding Commissioner, called the meeting to order. David Cox, 1st District, and Wayne Uthe, 2nd District, are present.

The Commission approved last week's minutes and invoices. The Commission approved brush letters and abates if presented.

James Lewis, Road and Bridge Supervisor, updated the Commission that the crew mowed around the Guthery River bridge by Jameson in Grand River Township.

OLD BUSINESS:

A new security system has been approved. Corwin Electric has confirmed they will install the outlet by the end of this week.

BRIDGES:

The Commission spoke to Lindsey Chaffin with Great River Engineering about BRO 001. She predicts construction will begin in May or June.
