July 1, 2026

The Honorable Daviess County Commission met on Wednesday, July 1, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. Jim Ruse, Presiding Commissioner, called the meeting to order. David Cox, 1st District, and Wayne Uthe, 2nd District, are present.

The Commission approved last week’s minutes and invoices. The Commission approved brush letters, court orders, and abates.
